Good News! The Mexican market has opened its doors to imports of British Pork for the first time.

This week pig marketing has seen much of the same as previous weeks, we have seen the EU spec of SPP move downwards 0.55p to average 158.70p/kg, this put the price 3.68p below the price for the same week last year but 5.69p above the five-year average, to put this in perspective the European price is this week is 118.78p/kg!

Cull sows this week have slipped away by 4p/kg, this is to do with the number of sows that are coming forward and the volume of sows being liquidated in Germany and other parts of the EU. We are seeing throughout the UK a huge backlog in the supply chain caused by labour issues which is reducing abattoir throughput. The NPA and other representative bodies are working hard with the government and the processors to try and alleviate this problem and find some common ground for solutions.
