



Market Report

2024 Week 18

A very steady week in pig marketing again, enough pigs to go round to meet demand. Talking to one or two larger processors this week, they would have great difficulty in buying or selling on extra pigs.

The SPP EU Spec stands at 211.06 this week which is a rise of +0.39p/kg, the AP EU Spec stands at 213.10 which is +1.17p/kg this week.

There is no money put in by any of the large processors this week, Sow prices have stood on and on the fresh meat front again prices have stood on and the smaller abattoirs have reported a steady trade.

There are certainly less pigs about, maybe the very changeable weather has had a lot to do with that but even if we got BBQ weather it might only be the fresh pork trade who would see demand from high street footfall increase. Some of the large processors will have pork in cold store.
